- Thanks to MCT we now have a 'Townsville Mountain Bike Destination Concept Report' completed by World Trail. Including Social and Economic Benefit Assessment and Ecological reports. This report details the expansion of Douglas MTB Park, Pallarenda and possible MTB trails on Magnetic Island. This report is the first step towards having Townsville as a MTB destination which will lead to funding from different levels of government for construction and maintenance. There is still a lot of work to do, however having the report funded and ready to go it will make it a great opportunity for the government.
- President discussed the following projects:
 - o This year the Mt Stuart DH trails got some much-needed machine works and maintenance.
 - o Maintenance works at Douglas have been detailed due to contractor availability, however, are booked for early in the year.
 - o We have some new picnic table and chairs thanks to Phil Thompson federal member for Herbet.
- This year we have held 20 events and had over 1,100 riders taken part.
- Next year we have we will be holding the QLD state Downhill Championship at Mt Stuart. The event will be held in June at Mt Stuart.
- Next year we also will be celebrating 30 years of the Rockwheelers MTB Club. We are planning an event in March to celebrate the club and induct some life members to the club. Please keep an eye out on social media for details.
